

Android Devices

- 1) Open the **Mail** app on your Android device.
- 2) Tap **Other (POP3/IMAP)**.
- 3) Type your full email address into the **Email Address** field.
- 4) Type your associated password into the **Password** field.
- 5) Tap **Next**.
- 6) Select **IMAP** from the **Protocol** dropdown.
- 7) Type the following into the **Server** field: **mail.b.hostedemail.com**
- 8) Select **SSL (Accept all certificates)** from the **Security Type** dropdown.
- 9) Verify the **Server Port** is **993**.
- 10) Tap **Next**. There will be a slight pause as the server settings are verified.
- 11) Verify the **Login Required** option is checked.
- 12) Type the following into the **SMTP Server** field: **mail.b.hostedemail.com**
- 13) Select **SSL (Accept all certificates)** from the **Security Type** dropdown. You may need to select the **Accept All Certificates** option. Verify the **Server Port** is **465**.
- 14) Tap **Next**. There will be a slight pause as the server settings are verified.
- 15) Type the name of the account in the **Account Name** field.
 - If you have multiple email addresses set up through your **Mail** application, this will be the name of this account. (ie: Personal, Work, NetDriven, etc.).
- 16) Type your full name into **Your Name** field.
- 17) Tap **Finish Setup**.
